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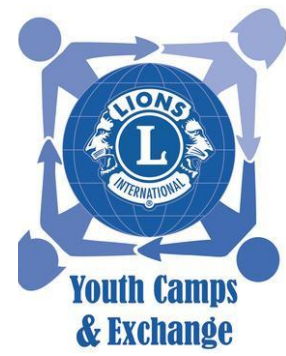

Youth Camps and Exchange

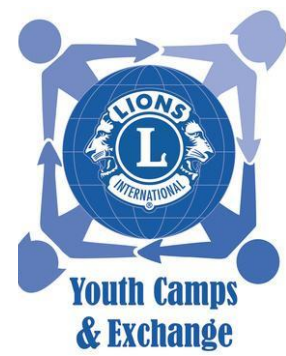

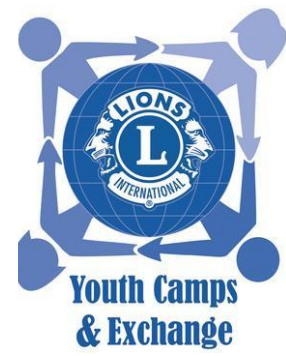
GENERAL RULES

- Youth Camp Exchange contributes to a better understanding of people of other countries. You must be willing to participate. You are to be highly motivated.
- English and Japanese are spoken in the camp.
- You should have meals what you are offered at the same time with others.
- Dietary concerns should be agreed upon before your arrival.
- Regardless of your age, you are not allowed to drink alcohol or to smoke cigarettes. You should decline when someone offers you.
- Driving a motor vehicle or scooter is not allowed.
- Bring some pocket money to pay for snacks, souvenirs, recreation, etc.
- Never lend nor borrow money, not only between visiting students but also between students and host family members.
- Do not make noise at public spaces and your rooms in hotels.
- It is not permitted for boys to enter girls' rooms at any time and vice versa.
- Keep your room clean and make your bed every morning.
- YCE members and Lions members will help you during the camp.
- If you feel sick or get into trouble, you should tell them openly at any time.
- If you don't follow the rules and cause any troubles, you will be ordered to return home immediately at your own expense.
- Your guardian is responsible for any incurred expenses of sickness, injuries etc.

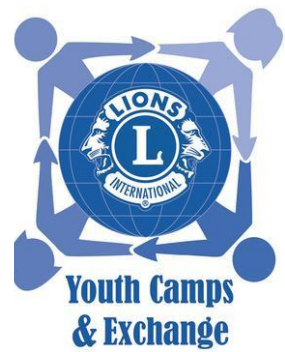

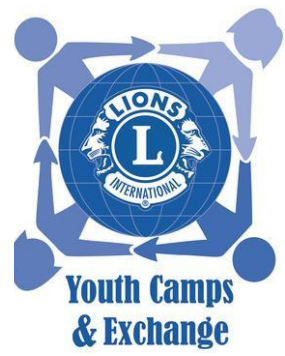

Ueno Campの最終日は歴史のおさらい。畳でもくつろげるようになりました。いざメインキャンプへ。



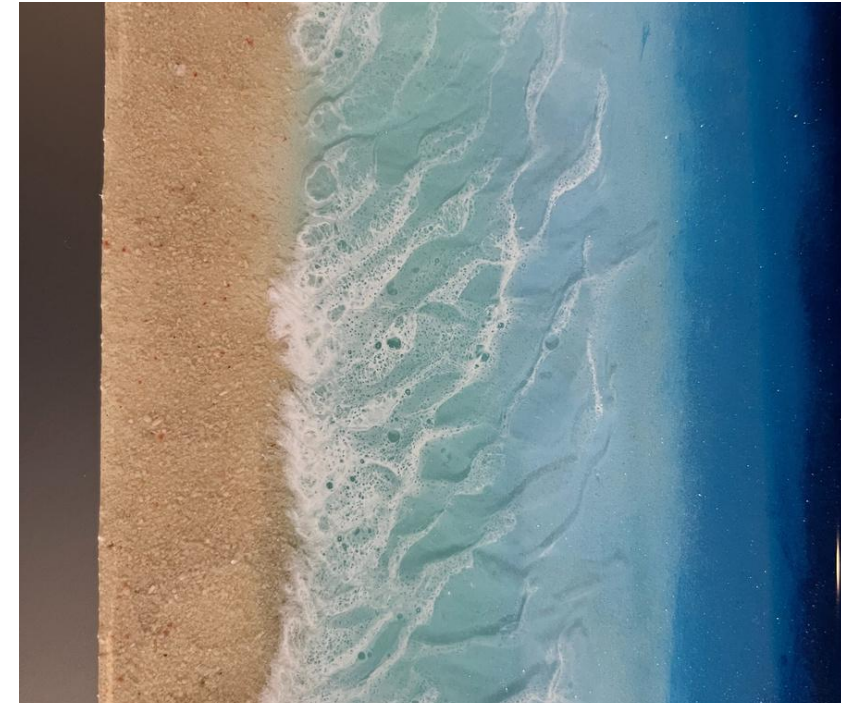
